**ORDER**

On November 4, 2009, notice of intent to adopt rule changes and notice of hearing were given regarding the proposal of the Commissioner of Insurance to amend the Rules and Regulations of the Safety Fire Commissioner by adopting Regulation Section 120-3-16 entitled "Rules and Regulations for Liquefied Petroleum Gases."

The proposal has been approved as to legality by the Attorney General and is evidenced by a letter dated December 23, 2009, from Amy Burns, Assistant Attorney General, Department of Law, State of Georgia. The proposed amendment was also transmitted to Sewell Brumby, Legislative Counsel, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 50-13-4(e), and forwarded by Mr. Brumby to the appropriate standing committees of the Senate and House of Representatives.

An opportunity was given to interested persons to participate in the proposed rulemaking by submitting their written data, views, or arguments by December 8, 2009, and an opportunity was given to persons to participate in the proposed rulemaking by submitting oral views, data, or arguments at a hearing held on December 10, 2009. No written comments were received in advance of the hearing, and one oral presentation was made at the hearing by a member of the public. Chris Stephens made a presentation for the Department. The Administrative Procedure Attorney, acting as the Hearing Officer, has recommended the adoption of the changes to

Regulations Chapter 120-3-16. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §§ 25-2-4 and 25-2-16, and as recommended by the Administrative Procedure Attorney, the Safety Fire Commissioner hereby adopts and promulgates the proposed amendments to the Rules and Regulations of the Office of the Safety Fire Commissioner, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

It is hereby ORDERED that the proposed amendments to Regulation Chapter 120-3-16 entitled "Rules and Regulations for Liquefied Petroleum Gases" are adopted and shall become effective twenty (20) days after the rules are filed in the Office of Secretary of State.
